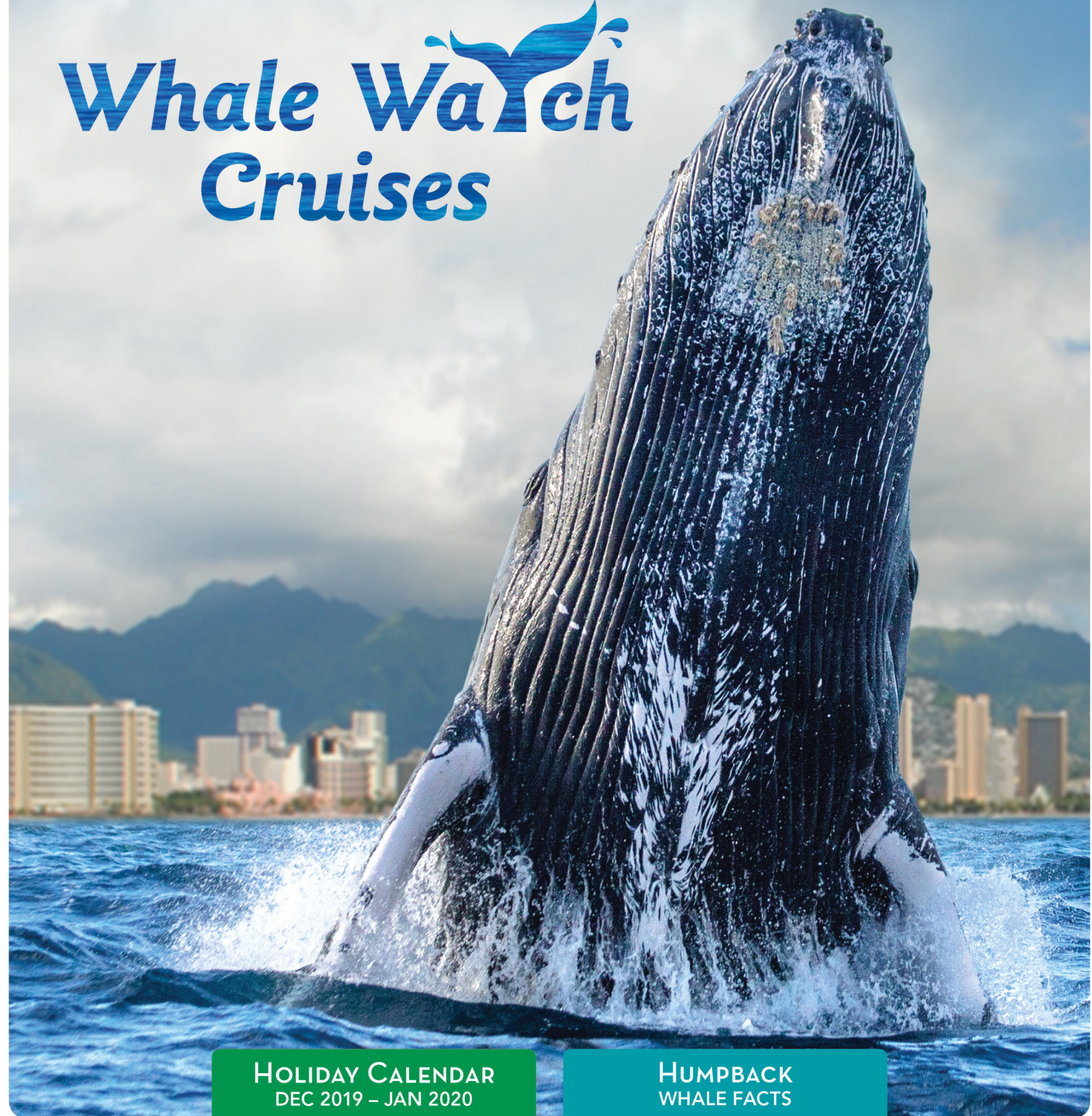








Humpback Whale Facts: Nature's Winter Wonder!

					
Mammals: Warm-blooded, give birth to live offspring & nourished with mother's milk.	Lifespan: They are said to live about 80 to 90 years.	Length: Adult male humpbacks are 38–42 feet long, while females are 40–45 feet.	Weight: Up to 40 tons. They build up fat during summer to sustain them in the winter.	Migration: NOAA estimates up to 12,000 humpbacks travel from Alaska to Hawaii.	36 Days: To complete 3,000-mile journey from Alaska.
					
Population: 60,000 humpbacks worldwide according to the World Wildlife Fund.	Why they Migrate: Travel to lower latitudes, such as Hawaii, for breeding & birthing.	Single Calf: Female produces every 2–3 years after an 11-month gestation.	Length of Calf: 13–16 feet when born and spend about a year with their mothers.	Mother & Calf Close Relationship: Often touch one another with their flippers.	Hawaii Law: Prohibited to approach whale within 333yd by air & 100yd by land or sea.
